Youth Spring Soccer League (4 years-12th Grade)

The Streamwood Park District soccer program teaches soccer skills, while promoting good sportsmanship, physical conditioning and having fun. U6 and U8 These two divisions are strictly instructional. U6 has no weekday practices and U8 may practice one day during the week with all games played on Saturdays.

U10, U12, U14 Leagues are part of the Intervillage Soccer program and will require some traveling to neighboring towns. Teams will practices one or two times per week depending on availability. Games will be played on Saturdays.

U18 The Intervillage league now includes high school players. All freshman through seniors will play on the same team. Boys will play in the Spring, and Girls will play in the Fall. This is a great opportunity to keep up your skills during your offseason at the high school level.

Open Registration Deadline: February 11

If registered after open registration, a late charge of \$5 will be added to the regular fee. All individuals who register late will be placed on a waiting list and are not guaranteed a roster position. Brackets are based on the child's grade for the 2011-12 School Year!

Participants may use the same uniform for both the Fall and Spring seasons. All new players in the spring are assigned to either new or existing teams. 0070-8 Uniform Fee

Any participant not wishing to sell the candy fundraiser, must pay the buy-out fee of \$34 at the time of registration. Failure to do so will result in the candy fundraiser being ordered for your child. Candy will cost \$60 at the time of uniform pickup. 0079-9 Candy Buy-out Fee

Girls Softball League (5-14 years old)



The Girls Softball program is run by the Streamwood Park District. The Key to the program is volunteer parents in various positions from team support to coaches. The season typically runs April through June and games are played at Tefft Middle School, Rahlfs Woods and Hoosier Grove. The 10U, 12U and 14U age divisions may play in an intervillage league.

Assessment day will be held on March 17 at the Community Center, 777 Bartlett Road. Assessment times are: 10U, 11 a.m.; 12U, 12 p.m.; 14U, 1 p.m.. Each girl will receive a uniform including a shirt, shorts, visor, and socks to keep. Each participant is responsible for her own mitt and bat, and cleats. Practices start after assessment day.

General Notes: Community Youth Leagues

- A candy fundraiser will be required for each child (maximum of two children per family) for specific leagues, for each season in efforts to keep the costs of the program low. At the time of registration you may opt out of the candy fundraiser (per child with a maximum of two children per family) by paying the buyout fee without candy. Any time after the registration deadline, the buyout option is no longer available.
- The fee for candy fundraiser is \$60, which will be paid at the time of uniform pick-up. No child will receive his or her uniform until the candy fundraiser fee is paid in full.
- Each child's parent or guardian must complete a "Parent Code of Ethics" form at the time of uniform pick-up. No child will receive his or her uniform until the Parent Code of Ethics form has been completed.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct **will not be tolerated**. Any parent or guardian engaging in improper behavior will be suspended from the next game. If the unsportsmanlike conduct persists, the next step is expulsion from any remaining games of the season.
- All team instruction is the responsibility of the coaches. At no time may any parent or guardian assume the role of a coach unless first obtaining approval and proper certifications from the Streamwood Park District Athletic Supervisor. All family members must remain in the designated spectator area.
